Additionally, Athelyia's artwork received the honor of "top 15" for elementary students. Great job, girls!



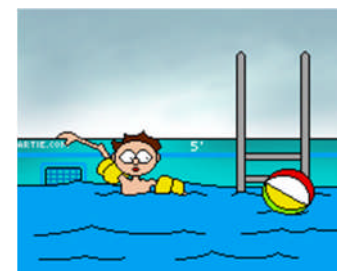
