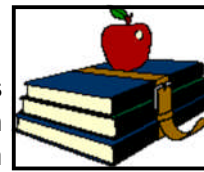

Handbook Reminders:

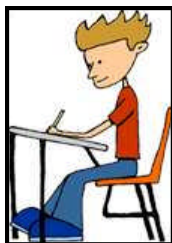
