MARCELLUS EARLY COLLEGE

Earn an Associate's Degree FREE while still in high school!

Marcellus Community School's application for Early College was recently approved by the Michigan Department of Education! Marcellus Early College will begin operations in the fall. The Marcellus Early College program will allow participating students the opportunity to earn an associate's degree, certificate, or up to 60 hours of college credit while still in high school. The college courses will be held at Southwestern Michigan College. Participation in the program is free to participating students. Students accepted and enrolled in the program commit to a 13th year of high school. A student will have one high school graduation requirement (class) withheld during the 12th grade. During the 13th year, the student will complete a full course load at Southwestern Michigan College. Students will also complete the final high school requirement in order to fulfill their high school diploma. (Students will be able to walk in graduation with their original class). There are eligibility requirements and students must complete an application to participate in this unique opportunity. Due to the very recent approval of the program, students and parents who are interested in this option must contact the high school counselor or principal right away. Incoming juniors will be the first cohort eligible to participate in this unique opportunity. Incoming juniors who are already registered to participate in dual enrollment in the fall may still apply to Marcellus Early College.

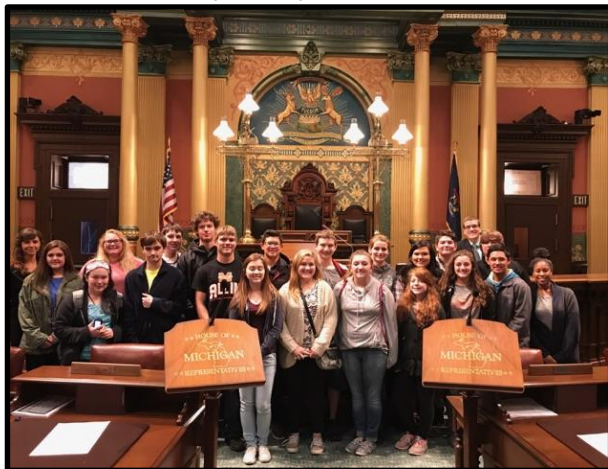
MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL TALENT SEARCH AGRICULTURAL CAREER AWARENESS DAY
