THE JUSTICES OF THE MICHIGAN SUPREME COURT BROUGHT THE COURT COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS PROGRAM TO CASS COUNTY AND POKAGON BAND OF POTAWATOMI ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24TH TO THE DALE LYON'S THEATER AT SMC. THIS PROGRAM, LAUNCHED IN 2007, AIMS TO PROVIDE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH A PROFOUND UNDERSTANDING OF MICHIGAN'S JUDICIAL SYSTEM AND THE APPELLATE COURTS. STUDENTS RECEIVED A BRIEFING ABOUT THE CASE THAT THE COURT HEARD DURING THE ORAL ARGUMENT. FOLLOWING THE ARGUMENT, THERE WAS A DEBRIEFING SESSION WITH THE ATTORNEYS WHO ARGUED THE CASE AND STUDENTS HAD THE EXCLUSIVE OPPORTUNITY TO MEET THE JUSTICES AND ASK QUESTIONS.
